



# ARTS DISTRICT LIBERTY STATION

The NTC Foundation is seeking interest from qualified Artists to “*Illuminate the Night*” with a temporary light Installation that corresponds with longer nights between November and March.

The light installation will be located within ARTS DISTRICT Liberty Station. Please see the map below for potential installation locations.



Between the months of November and January the Rady Children’s Ice Rink will be in place and has an estimated attendance of 100,000 visitors.

**SCOPE:** An environmental, outdoor light Installation either free standing, on the ground, on rooftops, projected, in nearby trees, triggered by movement or sound, or an “Instagram-able” background. No installations in the fountain will be approved.

Note: The installation is in the flight path to San Diego International Airport so be mindful of not interfering with the flight path or FAA regulations. You will work in conjunction with a structural engineer for approval. Location will be dependent upon total electricity needed.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Artists located within Southern California who have experience in creating temporary light installations are encouraged to submit a proposal for consideration.

- INSTALLATION DATE:** Installed by Friday, November 1, 2019
- BUDGET:** \$8,000 for the all-inclusive budget (design, fabrication, installation, maintenance, and de-installation).
- PUBLICITY:** Participate in onsite and media promotions, including First Fridays during the months of November and December (Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> and Dec. 6<sup>th</sup>).
- SELECTION PROCESS:** Applicants will be reviewed by the NTC Foundation's Art in Public Places Committee. Liberty Station Community Association will approve site logistics.
